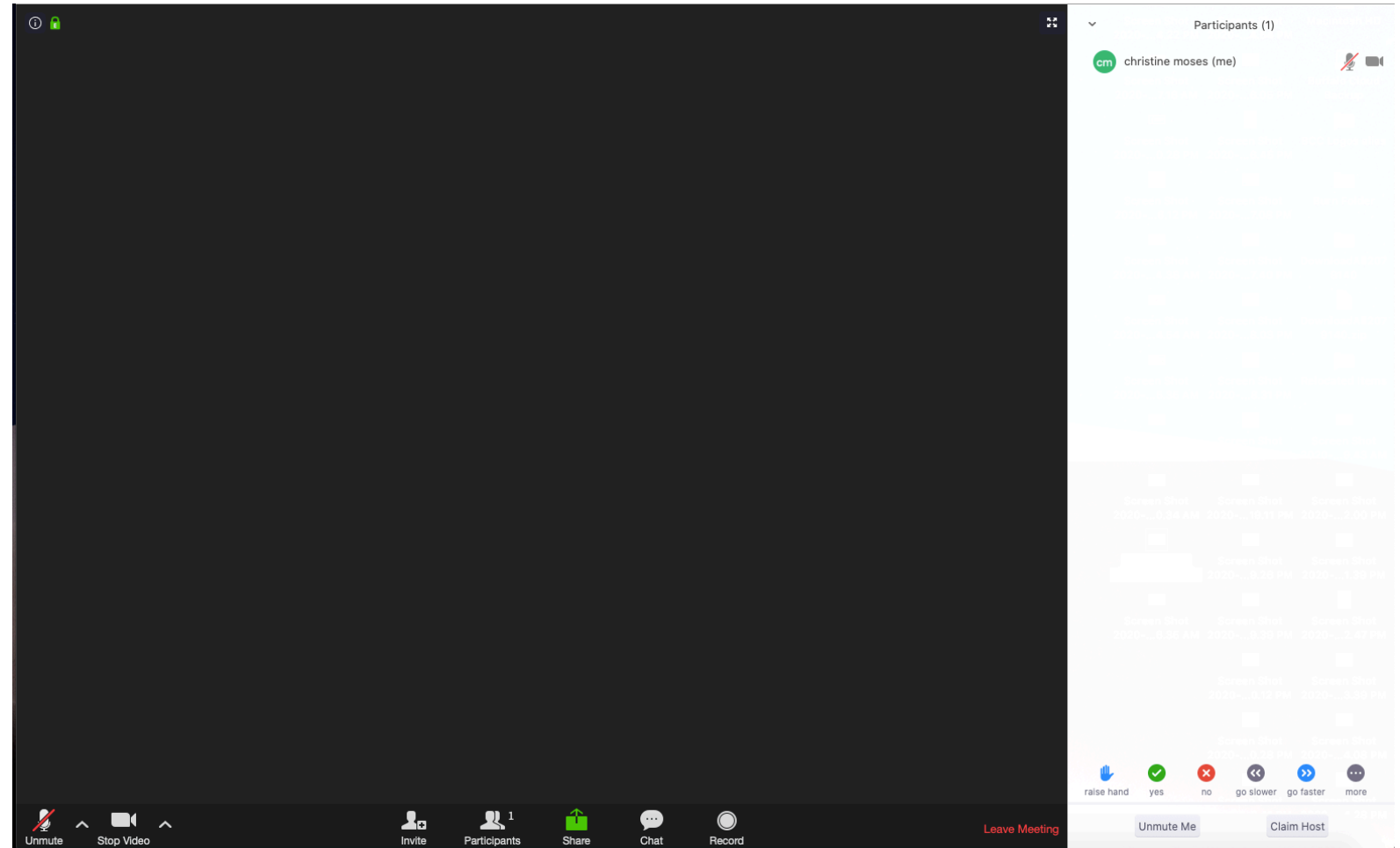

When I call on CAC member, you will need to unmute – click on the microphone at the bottom left – to be heard.



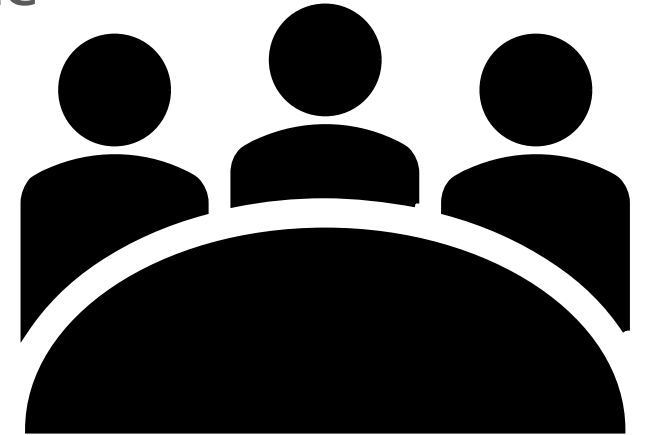

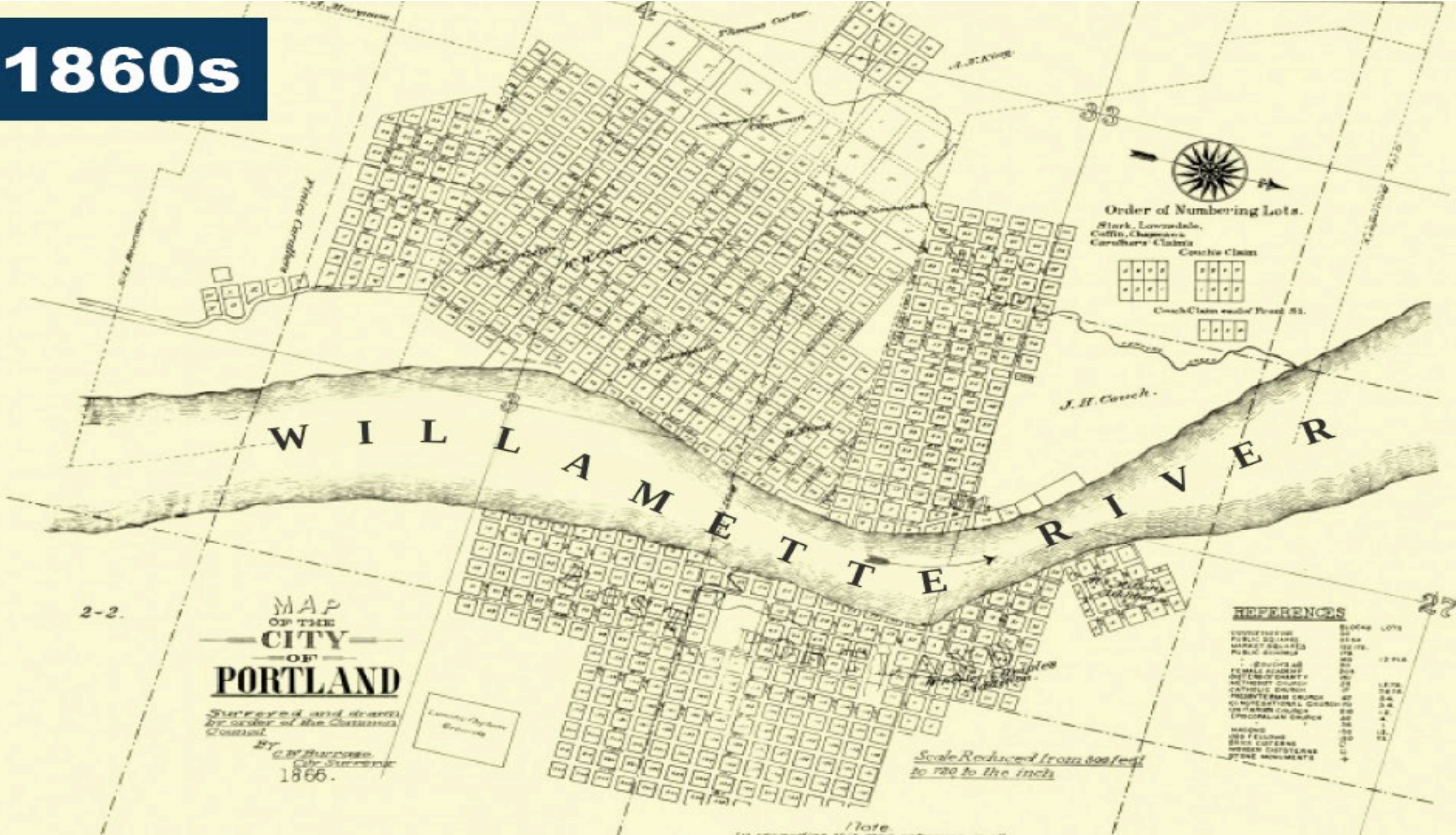
- We will see 11 different slides representing more than 200 year's worth of maps and photos of the Albina neighborhood

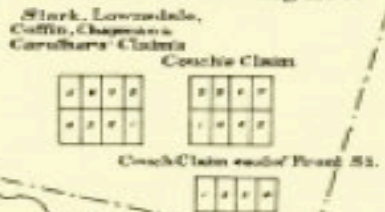

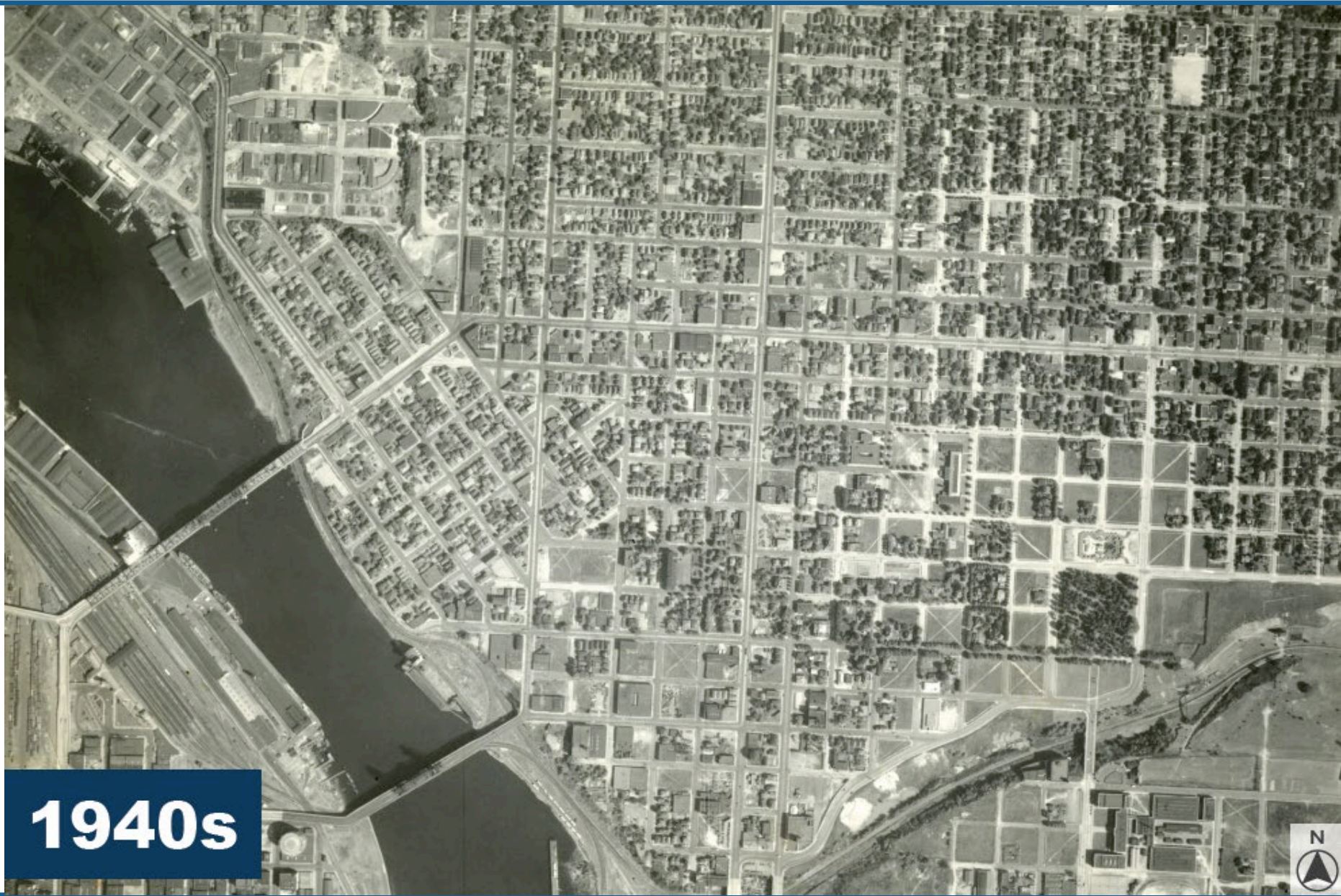

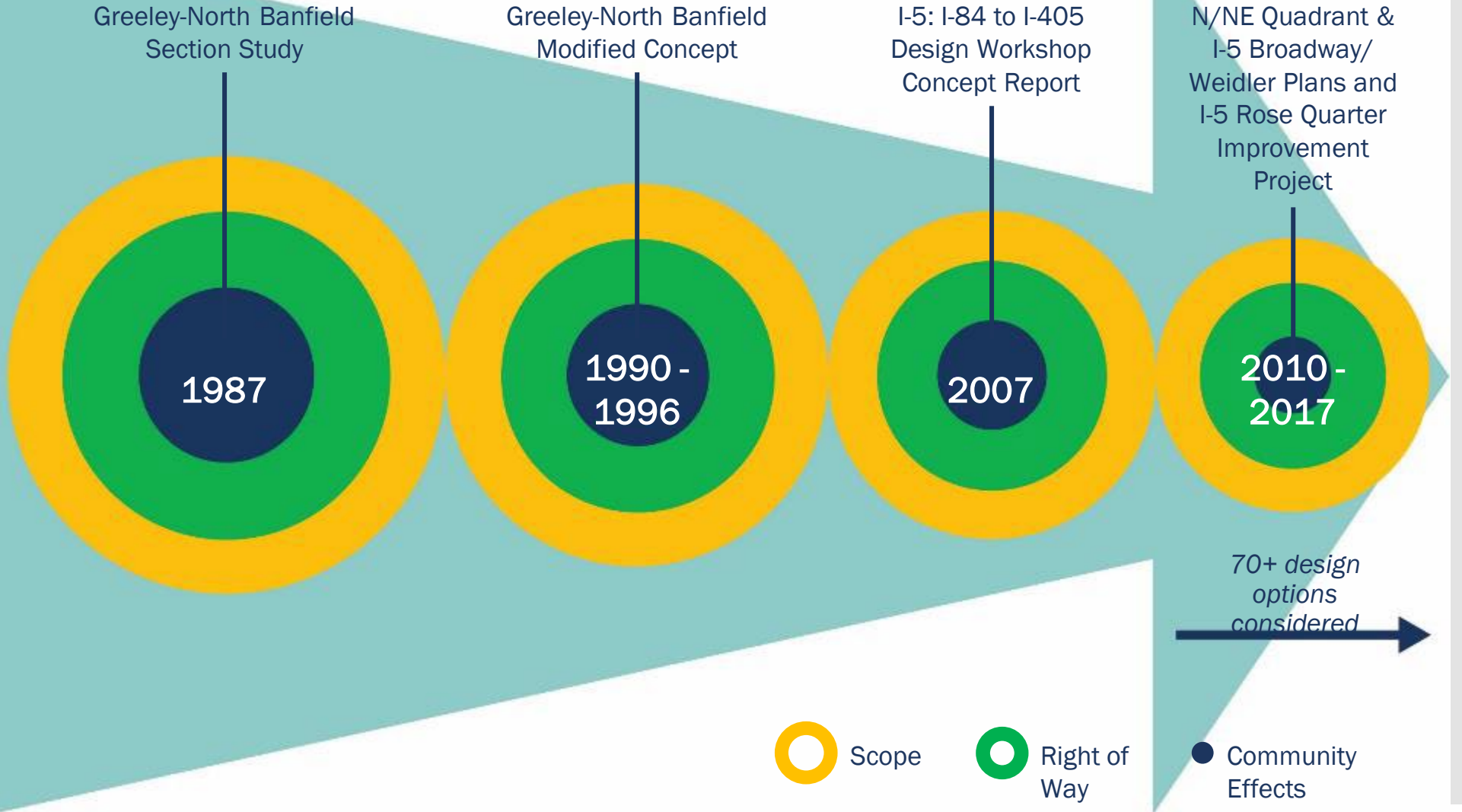
