Anticipated 2025 Milestones

The following milestones are anticipated to occur in 2025. We will continue to provide updates on these milestones and timing as more information becomes available.

I-5 Rose Quarter Improvement Project

Q1: COAC Resumes Meeting

The COAC will resume meeting in 2025 to help prepare the project for the start of construction and will continue to provide input through completion.

Q2: 30% Design Draft Plans Submitted

30% Design sets the project footprint, general scope, and confirms design parameters. Upon completion, project footprint will be confirmed.

Q3: Start of 60% Design for Broadway Weidler Phase 1 Package

60% Design includes a higher level of design detail and begins to define street elements like drainage, landscaping, signing, striping, street lighting, etc.

Q3: Start of Phase 1A Construction

The scope of the early work packages is being finalized based on available funding to include stormwater improvements, and bridge preservation and seismic resiliency improvements.

City Projects

Q1-Q3: RAPP Community Engagement

There will be opportunities in 2025 for technical work to interact and meet community expertise through engagement with the HAAB and public. More information will be shared with the HAAB as the order of public events and engagement opportunities is confirmed.

Q2: RAPP Land Use Scenarios

BPS will be developing the land use scenarios for the broader district through June 2025 and developing draft level proposals to bring to the public. Scenarios will be developed based on AVT/HAAB highway cover summer 2024 work, EcoNW's preliminary economic analysis, and existing conditions, including urban design and land use plans. Scenarios will be finalized in summer 2025.

• Q3: Lower Albina Streetscape Project

PBOT will hiring a consultant in Q2 and expect to commence 30% design for the Lower Albina Streetscape Project in July 2025.
