RESTORING NEIGHBORHOOD CONNECTIONS AND IMPROVING HOW PEOPLE MOVE THROUGH THE ROSE QUARTER

For decades, Interstate 5 has created a physical divide between neighborhoods in the Albina area, limiting local street connections and making it more difficult for people to move safely and efficiently through the district.

The I-5 Rose Quarter Improvement Project helps restore those connections by improving local streets, creating new crossings over the freeway and expanding safe travel options.

These improvements will make it easier and safer for residents, workers and visitors to move through the Rose Quarter—whether walking, biking, rolling or driving—while strengthening links between neighborhoods, businesses and community destinations.

By restoring key street crossings and improving how people move through the area, the project supports the long-term revitalization of the Albina neighborhood and the surrounding district.

IMPROVING LOCAL CONNECTIONS

- A new **Hancock Street crossing on the highway cover over I-5**, adding an additional east–west connection across the freeway
- A new **pedestrian and bicycle bridge** connecting neighborhood walking and biking networks
- **Improved sidewalks, bike lanes, and street lighting** throughout the project area
- **Accessible curb ramps and safer crossings** to improve mobility for all users

Restore Neighborhood Connections

New crossings over I-5 help reconnect streets and neighborhoods that were divided by the freeway.



Safer Streets for Everyone

Upgraded sidewalks, crossings and lighting improve safety for people walking, biking, rolling and driving.



Improved Transportation Choices

New connections for people walking, biking and using mobility devices will make it easier for people to travel through the Rose Quarter without driving.



Access to Community Destinations

Improved street connections make it easier to reach local businesses, community spaces, Memorial Coliseum and the Moda Center.

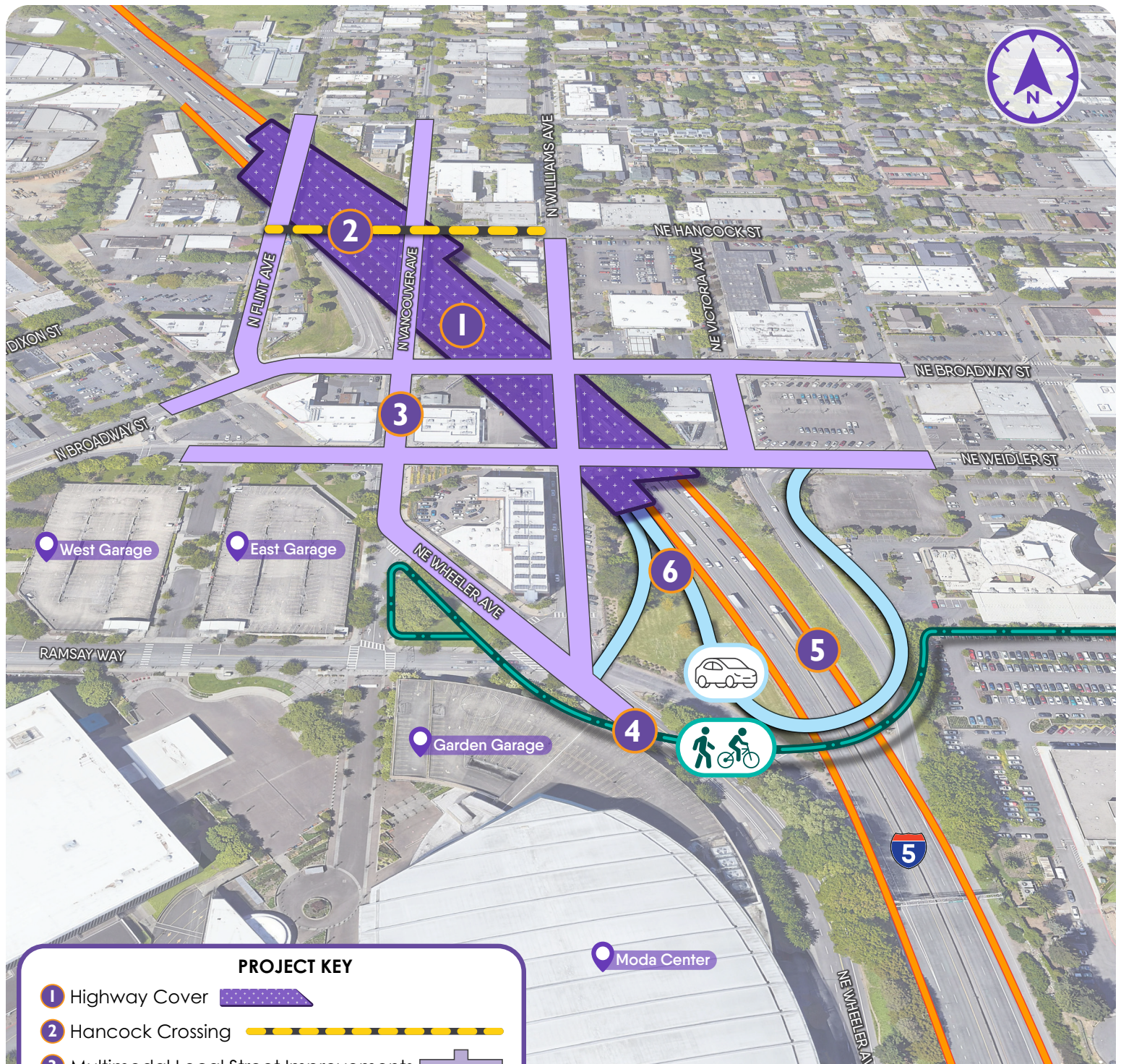
