

# **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

The purpose of the I-5 Rose Quarter Improvement Project is to improve safety and congestion where three major interstates converge and to reconnect the Albina neighborhood through the construction of a highway cover over a portion of I-5.

Project benefits include improving safety and mobility on local streets, creating new space for community development and developing a diverse and skilled workforce. Some of the key project improvements are:

- New ramp-to-ramp auxiliary lanes and wider shoulders on I-5 to improve safety and reduce congestion at the state's top traffic bottleneck.
- A highway cover over I-5 that reconnects local streets and creates new community spaces on top.
- Relocation of the I-5 southbound off-ramp from N Broadway/N Vancouver Avenue to the south, connecting with NE Wheeler Avenue.
- Local street improvements including wider paths, accessible curb ramps, better lighting and protected bike lanes.

For a large and complex project like this one, it was important to adopt project values that not only guide our work, but represent the community the project is in.

Community Input and Transparent Decision-Making: Have communityinformed and involved decisionmaking through a communityconnected, transparent and inclusionary process.




**Mobility Focus:** Increase connectivity for the traveling public and local community.

### WHAT IS A HIGHWAY COVER?

A highway cover is a structure built over a highway (like a very wide bridge) that will reconnect local streets and create new community spaces for future development and economic opportunities. Depending on the final design, the cover will be able to support buildings from three to six stories tall. When standing on the highway cover, you won't see much of I-5 since traffic will be below it.

Please note that the graphic to the right is for illustrative purposes only and does not represent a final design; the highway cover development process will be led by the City of Portland, in partnership with ODOT, and strong community involvement.
