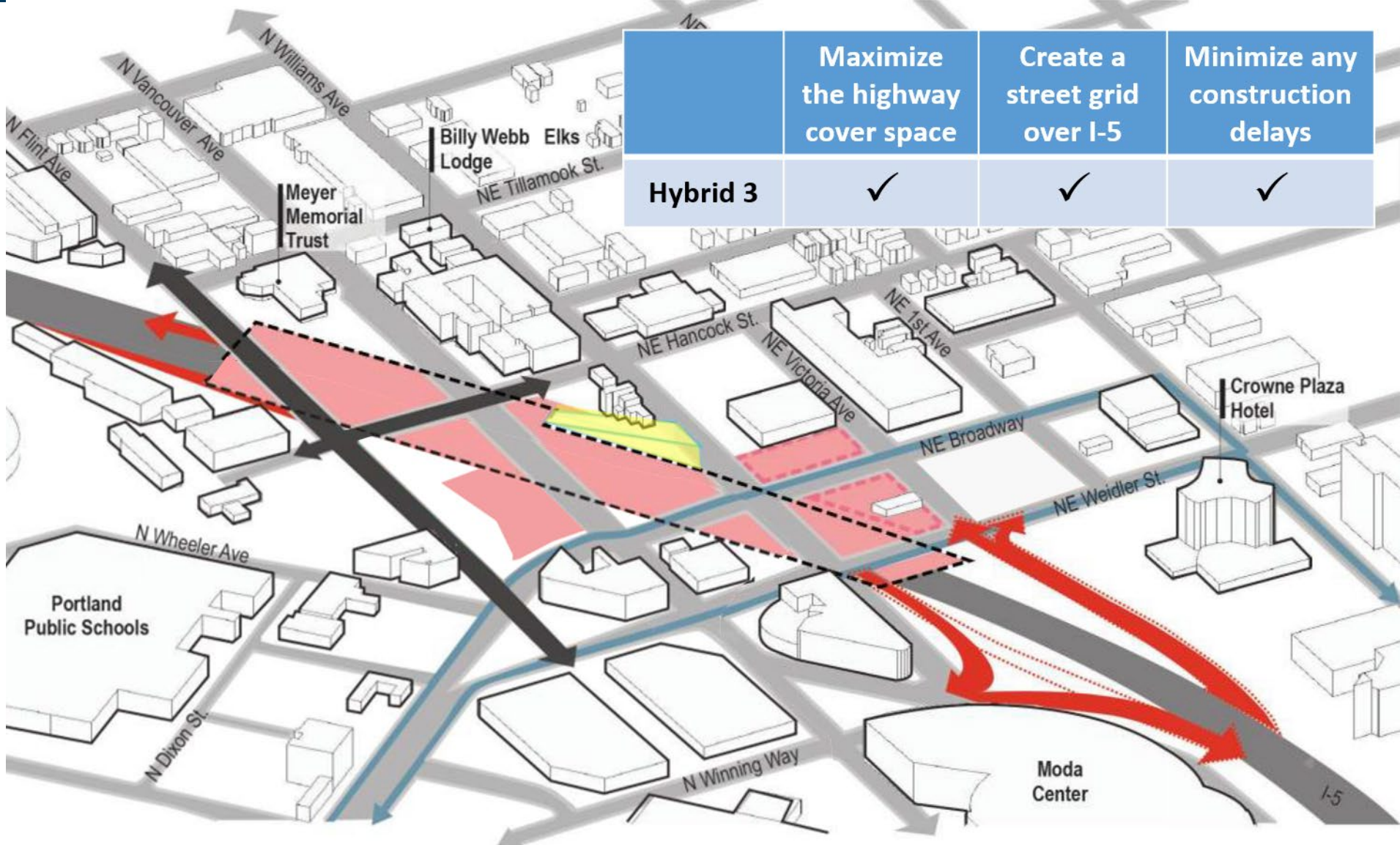

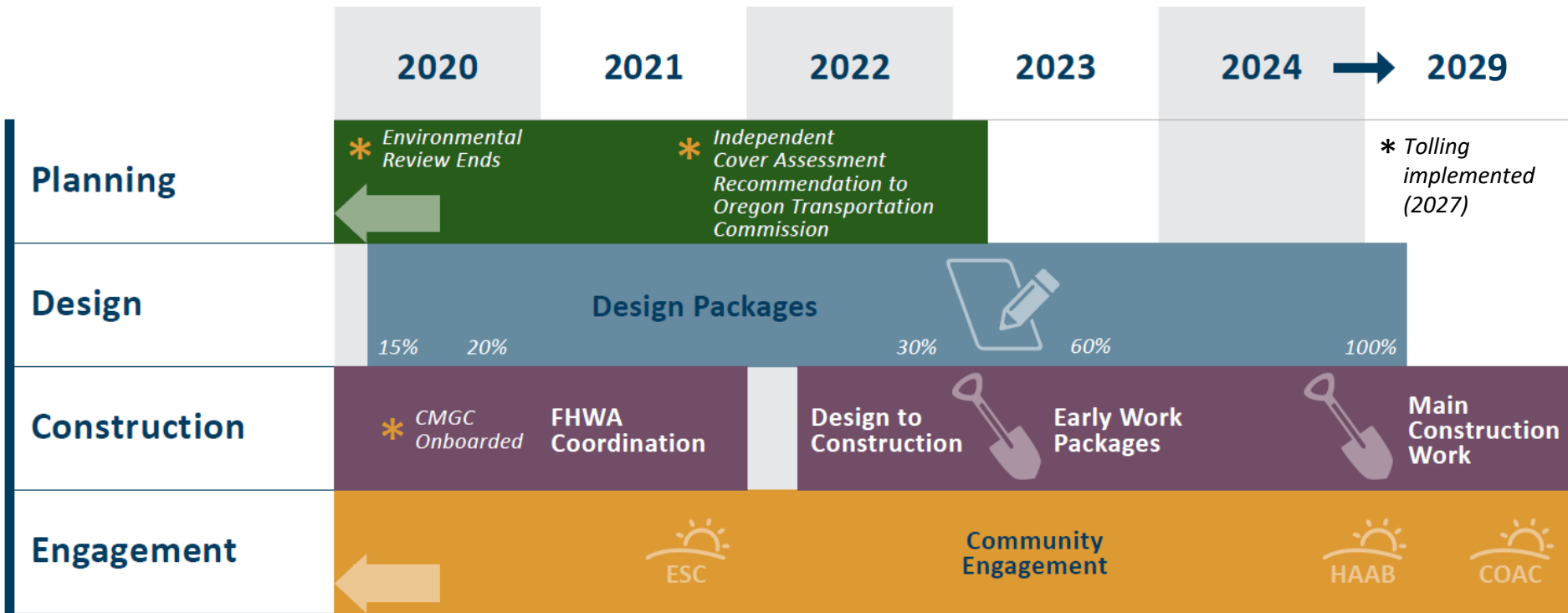

Next Steps

- Develop necessary intergovernmental agreements (*Fall 2021*)
- Advance design of highway cover concept: Progress from 5% concept (*Summer 2022*)
- Proceed with technical and environmental analyses for highway cover concept (*Summer 2022*)
- Conduct more detailed cost estimate of highway cover concept, develop an initial finance plan for project, and update Diversity Plan (*Summer 2022*)

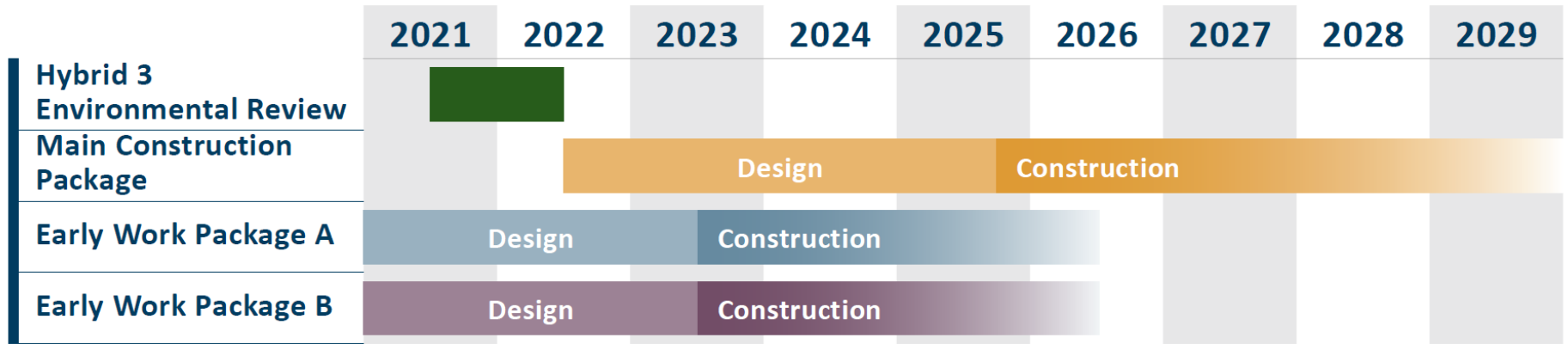
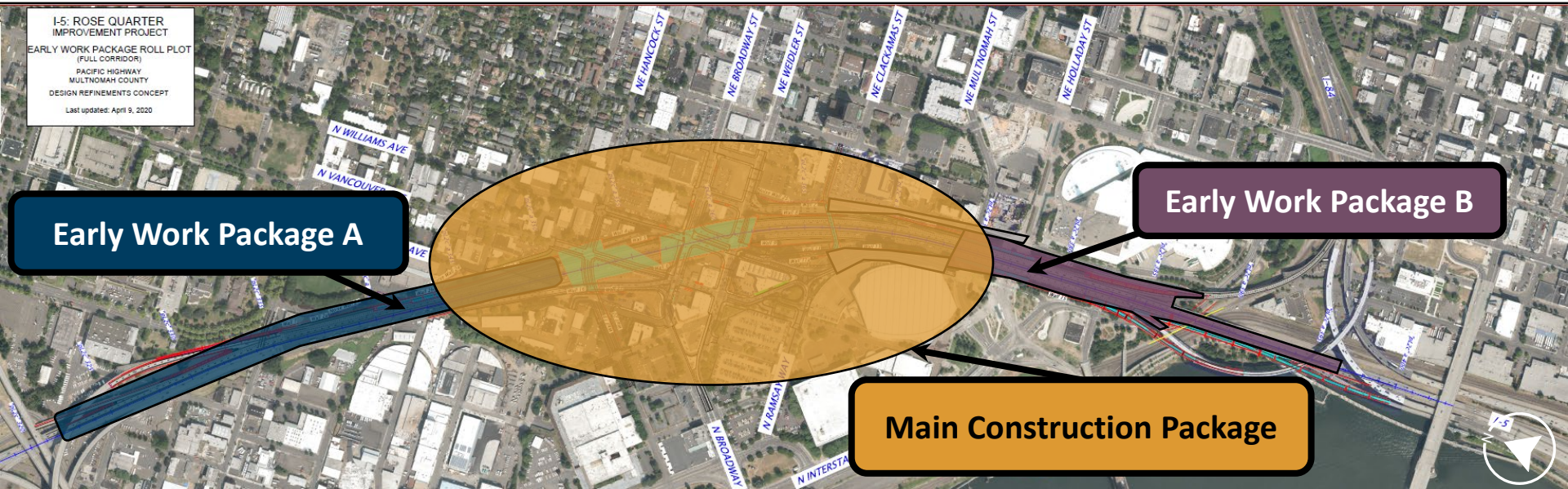


Overall Project Limits

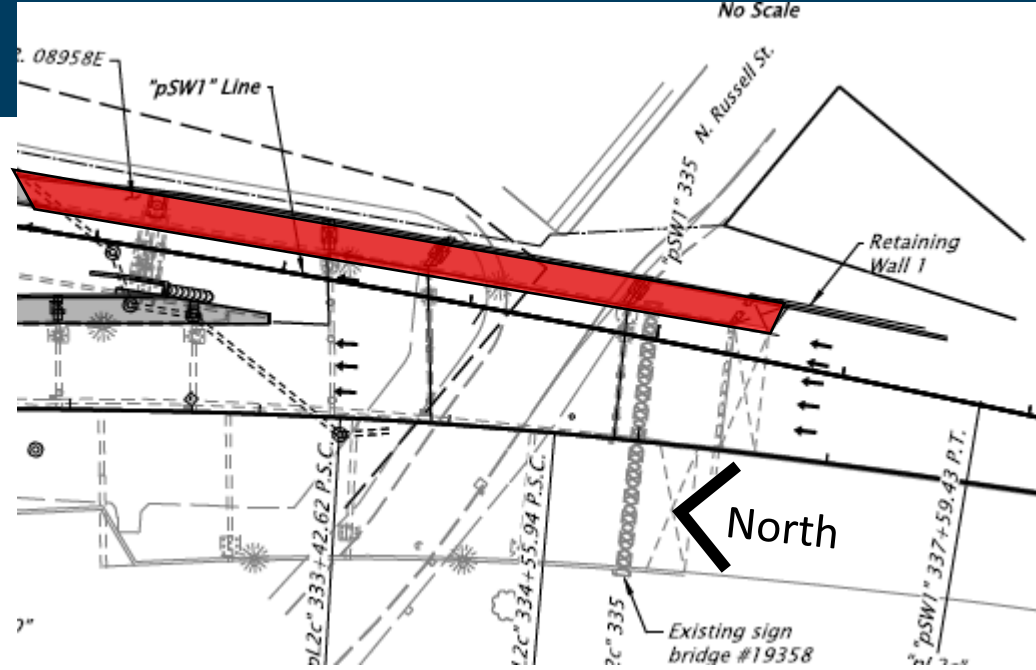
